- Que. 1 : What are the specified conditions for the admissibility of elect record ?
- Que. 2 : When an electronic record can be admitted in evidence by way of secondary evidence ?
- Que. 3 : Whether an electronic record can be used as a primary evidence ?
- Que. 4 : Whether intercepted telephone call in a CD and CDR which were without a certificate u/s 65B of Evidence Act are admissible ?
- Que. 5 : What are the requisites for admissibility of intercepted telephone calls in evidence ?
- Que. 6 : Whether E mail received is primary or secondary evidence ? How it will be proved ?
- Que. 7 : Whether the sealing of the recorded conversation is required in civil cases ?
- Que. 8 : Whether certificate under Section 65-B of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 can be produced at subsequent stage ?
- Que. 9 : When can a condition as contemplated under Section 65-B can be dispensed of with regard to electronic record?

- Que.17 : Where CCC TV footage makes it clear that on the date, time and place of incident the accused robbed and injured victim and where on the other hand due to any reason test identification parade of the accused taken in said case is not reliable, whether in such circumstances, for the identification of the accused CCC TV footage can be relied upon ?
